Advent is about the "coming days." God's people have always lived in great expectation, but that expectation finds specific, repeated enunciation in the texts appointed for these four weeks. The ancients anticipated a "righteous Branch to spring up for David." The Thessalonians awaited "the coming of our Lord Jesus with all the saints." Our Lord's contemporaries hoped for the time "to stand before the Son of Man." With them we eagerly await the coming days: another Christmas celebration, a second coming, and the advent of our Lord in word and supper.

WHITE BEAR EMERGENCY FOOD SHELF



The Giving Tree is up for 2018. So far this year we have received names for 6 families and 39 individuals.








SUNDAY SCHOOL INTER-GENERATIONAL CLASSES DECEMBER 16 AND 23

This week's focus: Approaching the Threshold


Approaching threshold moments, there are a bunch of unresolved and disturbing feelings. Life is transient and fragile. Suddenly changes can happen, and we can find ourselves unsettled, restless, and facing an uncertain and unknown future. Fear and petulant resistance are real forces with which we must contend. What lies ahead is unknown and uncharted territory. We wonder with every ounce of spiritual strength what lies ahead.

This week's guiding Word: Isaiah 11:1-10

¹A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. ²The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

³His delight shall be in the fear of the LORD. He shall not judge by what his eyes see or decide by what his ears hear; ⁴but with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked. ⁵Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist, and faithfulness the belt around his loins. ⁶The wolf shall live with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the kid, the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them. ⁶The cow and the bear shall graze, their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. ⁶The nursing child shall play over the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put its hand on the adder's den. ⁶They will not hurt or destroy on all my holy mountain; for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea. ⁶On that day the root of Jesse shall stand as a signal to the peoples; the nations shall inquire of him, and his dwelling shall be glorious.
