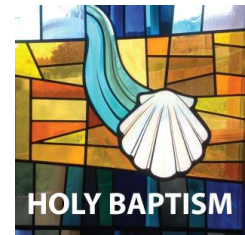

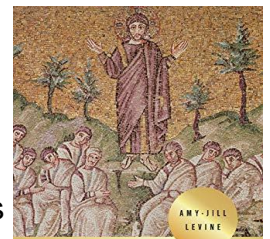
Please note that we will be following the COVID guidelines that the church has set up. Masks are required and social distancing must be followed. No restrooms will be available.
